# Verbs in the 1st and 3rd Person Plural - AR Verbs

When referring to the **we** form of the verb, cut off the **-AR** and add **-amos**.

When referring to the **they** form of the verb, add **-an** instead.

**My friends and I** throw eggs.

Mis amigos y yo lanz**amos**  
huevos.

**My friends** throw eggs.

Mis amigos y yo lanz**an** huevos.



## Verbs in the 1st and 3rd Person Plural - ER and -IR Verbs

When referring to the **we** form of the verb, cut off the **-ER/-IR** and add **-emos** for **-ER** verbs and **-imos** for **-IR** verbs. When referring to the **they** form of the verb, add **-en** instead.

**My friends and I** eat cake.

Mis amigos y yo com**emos**  
pasteles.

**My friends** eat cake.

Mis amigos com**en** pasteles.
