#### Verbs in the 1st and 3rd Person Plural - ER and -IR Verbs

When referring to the **we** form of the verb, cut off the **-ER/-IR** and add **-emos** for **-ER** verbs and **-imos** for **-IR** verbs. When referring to the **they** form of the verb, add **-en** instead.

My friends and I eat cake.

Mis amigos y yo comemos

pasteles.

My friends eat cake.

Mis amigos com**en** pasteles.
