

# Using verb + infinitive constructions



**Aller** + infinitive = I'm going to \_\_




Je **vais** = I go/I'm going




Tu **vas** = You go/You're going



Il **va** = I go/I'm going



Elle **va** = I go/I'm going



On **va** = You go/You're going  
We go/We're going

**Vouloir** + infinitive = I **want** to \_\_




Je **veux** = I want/I'm wanting




Tu **veux** = You want/You're wanting



Il **veut** = He wants/He's wanting



Elle **veut** = He wants/He's wanting



On **veut** = You want/You're wanting  
We want/We're wanting



# Making arrangements to go out

- 1) To say what we're going to do, we use the verb  
\_ aller \_ with an infinitive.
- 2) To say 'I want to' we use the verb vouloir with an  
\_ infinitive .
- 3) I want = \_ je veux
- 4) I go/I'm going = \_ je vais
- 5) you want = \_ tu veux \_
- 6) he/she wants = \_ il/elle veut
