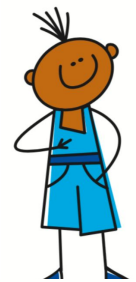
Present Tense - Regular -er verbs

Rigol**er** - To laugh

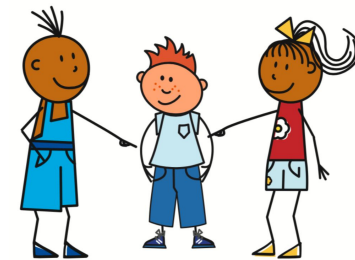

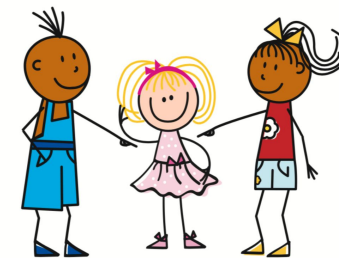

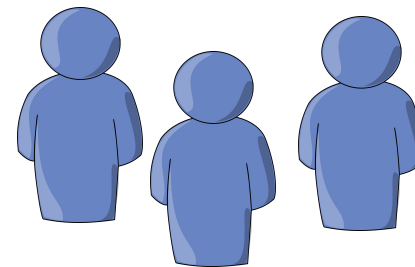

I am laughing

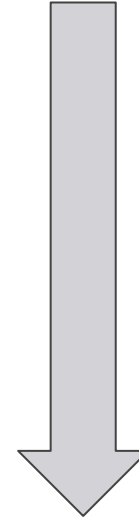

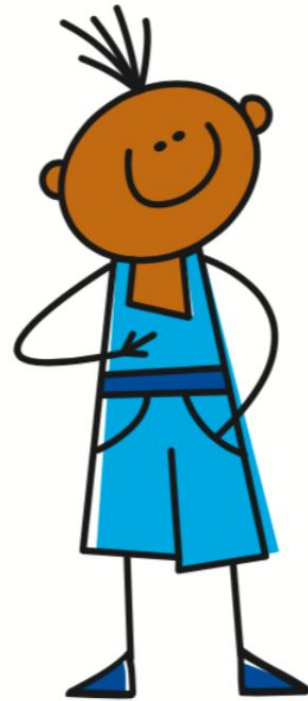

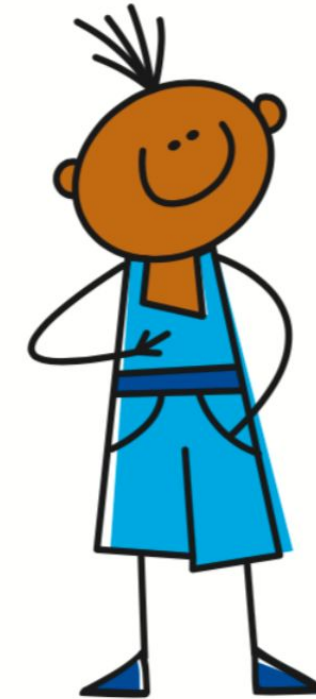
Regular -er verbs - present continuous



Je rigole**e** = I laugh



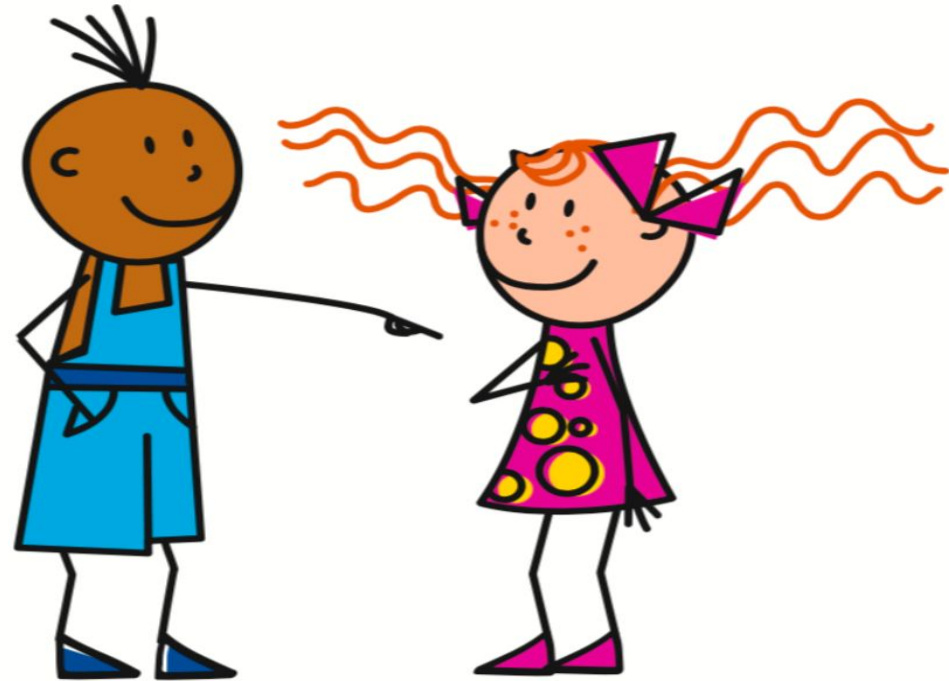
Je rigole**e** = I **am** laughing

Regular -er verbs - present continuous



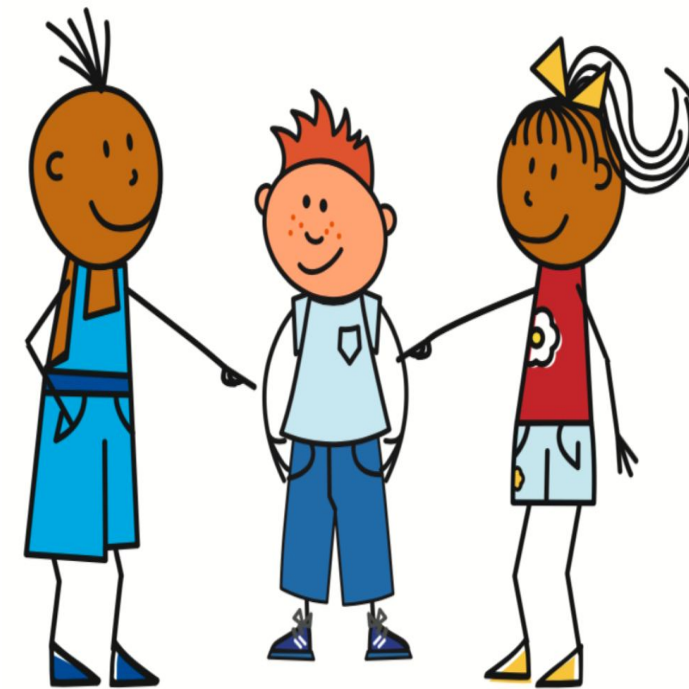
Il rigole
