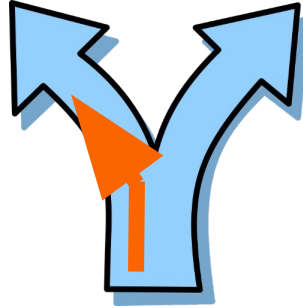

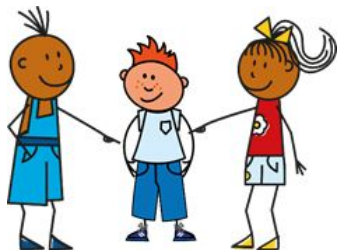

Regular adjective agreement

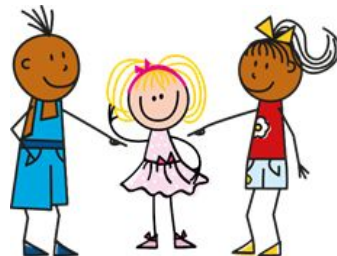
Adjectives need to **agree** with the noun they describe.

Il **est** amusant



He is funny

Elle est amusante



She is funny

'e' is added



Regular adjective agreement

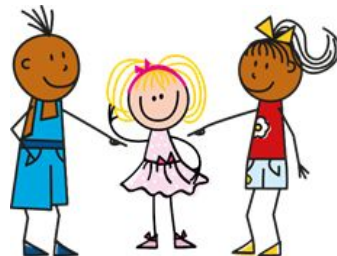
What happens when the adjective already ends in an 'e'?

Il est triste



He is sad

Elle est triste



She is sad

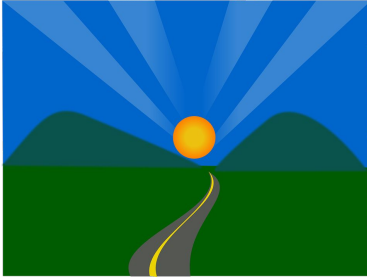
Answer: nothing changes



beau - beautiful (irregular adjective)

Adjectives need to **agree** with the noun they describe

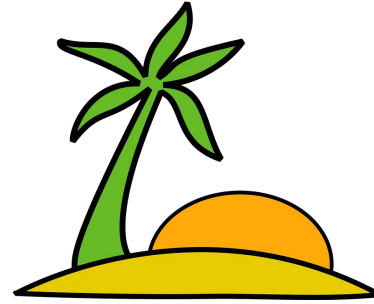
beau = beautiful



Refers a masculine noun

Add an 'x' if the masculine noun is plural.

belle = beautiful



Refers to a feminine noun

Add an 's' if the feminine noun is plural.



vieux - old (irregular adjective)

Adjectives need to **agree** with the noun they describe

vieux = old



Refers to a singular masculine noun

Stays the same if the masculine noun is plural.

vieille = old



Refers to a feminine noun

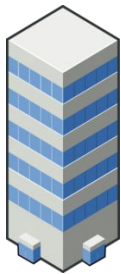
Add an 's' if the feminine noun is plural.



nouveau - new (irregular adjective)

Adjectives need to **agree** with the noun they describe

nouveau = new



Refers to a masculine noun

Add an 'x' if the masculine noun is plural.

nouvelle = new



Refers to a feminine noun

Add an 's' if the feminine noun is plural.
