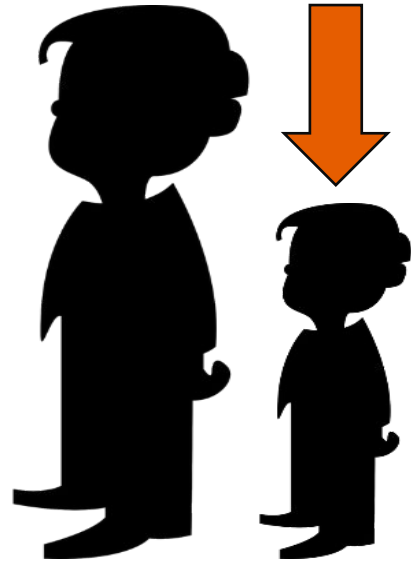

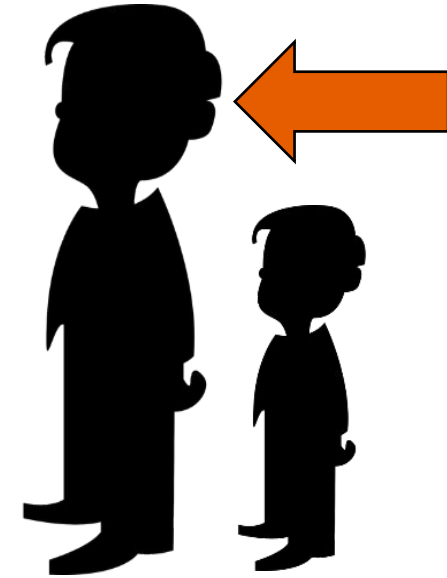

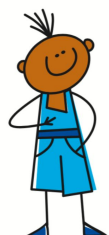

To form the present tense with a regular ER verb, remove the ER from the infinitive and add the correct ending.

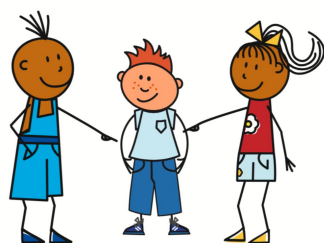
Rigoler - To laugh



Je rigole**e** - I laugh



Tu rigole**es** - You laugh



Il/Elle rigole**e** - He/she laughs



Nous rigol**ons** - We laugh



Vous rigol**ez** - You (pl) laugh



Ils/Elles rigol**ent** - They laugh
