<i>clamore</i>	with a shout, noise	<i>(primo) anno</i>	in/on the (first) year
<i>gladio</i>	with a sword	<i>(primo) die</i>	in/on the (first) day
<i>(his) verbis</i>	with (these) words	<i>(prima) hora</i>	in/on/at the (first) hour
<i>igni</i>	with fire	<i>illo tempore</i>	at that time
<i>magna cura</i>	with great care	<i>(prima) luce</i>	at (first) light/dawn
<i>magna voce</i>	with/in a great voice	<i>(media) nocte</i>	at (mid)night
