Foot on floor bass/kick drum.


Spatula on seat of chair - snare drum.

Of course, you can also use a drumkit or an app!







Playing the walking bass line



On the keyboard - take the chord sequence from last lesson and play as broken chords.

For bass, guitar and ukulele - read a tab score to find the notes on the fingerboard of your instrument.

READING TAB

- 1. The lines are the strings on the instrument.
- The numbers tell us in which fret to place your fingers.
- 3. 0 is an open string no fingers needed on the fingerboard.
