3. Add the water.

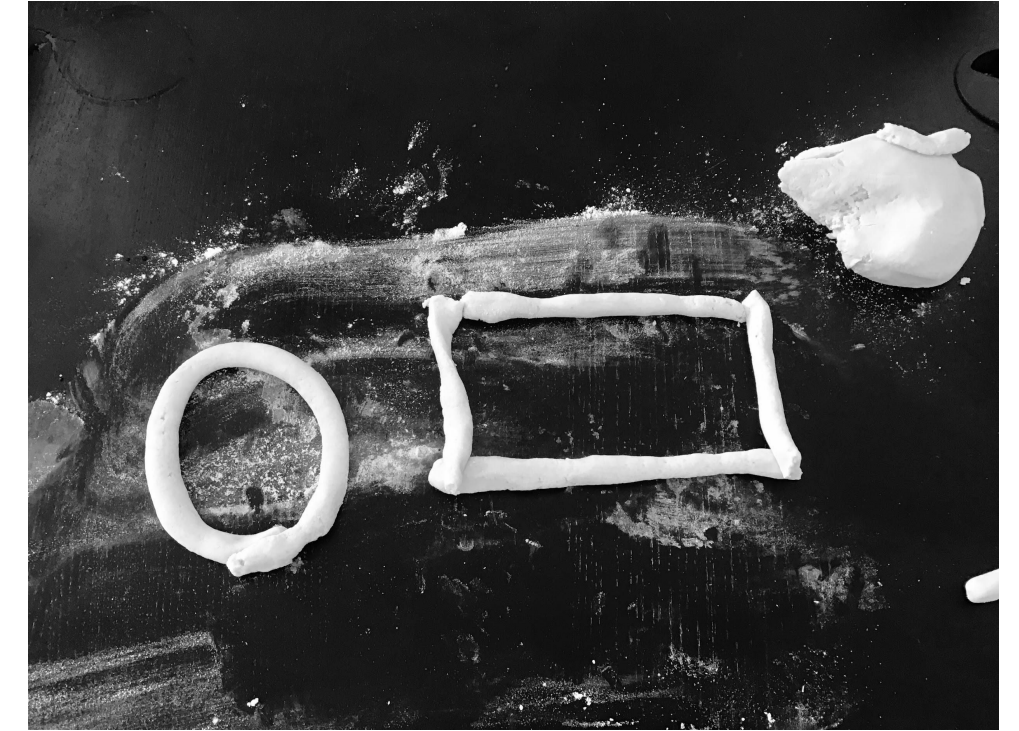




4. Mix everything together.
