La liaison


When a [SFC] is followed by a **vowel**, it is pronounced.

Sometimes, the [SFC] adopts a new sound and joins itself to the beginning of the next word.

This pronunciation change is known as **liaison**.











Making comparisons

plus (adjective) que moins (adjective) que aussi (adjective) que

meilleur(e,s) que pire que

more (adjective) than less (adjective) than as (adjective) as

better than worse than

All adjectives must agree with the nouns they describe!



Comparing French schools [2/3]

1. "Leurs propres vêtements" means =	their own clothes
2. To say "more than" in French, we use =	plus que
3. To say "less than" in French, we use =	moins que
4. "Pire que" means =	worse than
5. "Meilleur (e,s) que" means =	better than
