# Making a sock puppet

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## For this lesson you will need:

- Socks
- Pen and paper
- Scissors (parent / carer supervision is necessary)
- Sellotape
- Items to decorate your puppet (e.g. jewellery, coloured paper)

Adult support will be required.



# Getting ready

First, find the things you will need



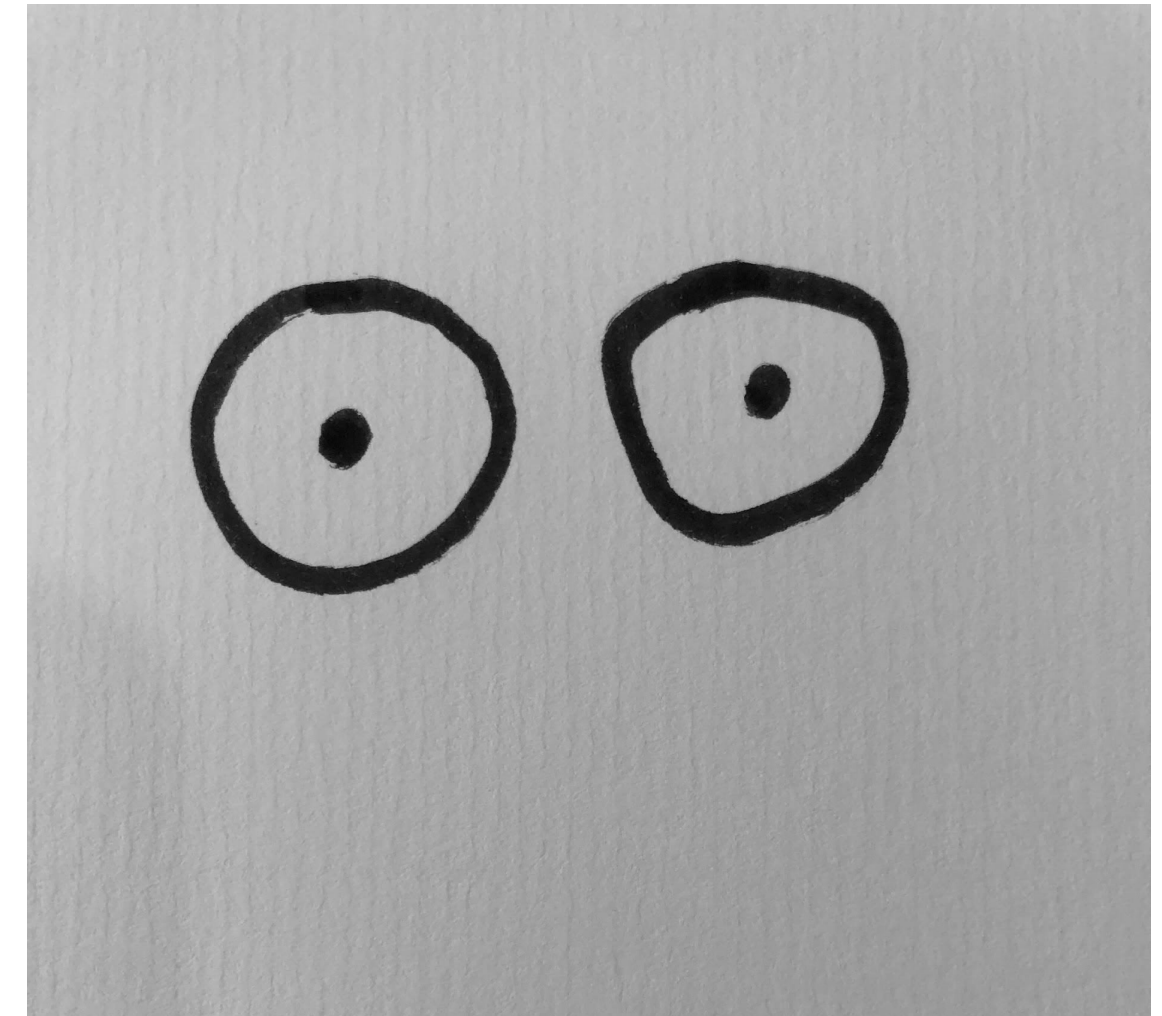
# Step 1

1. Choose a sock and lay it flat



## Step 2

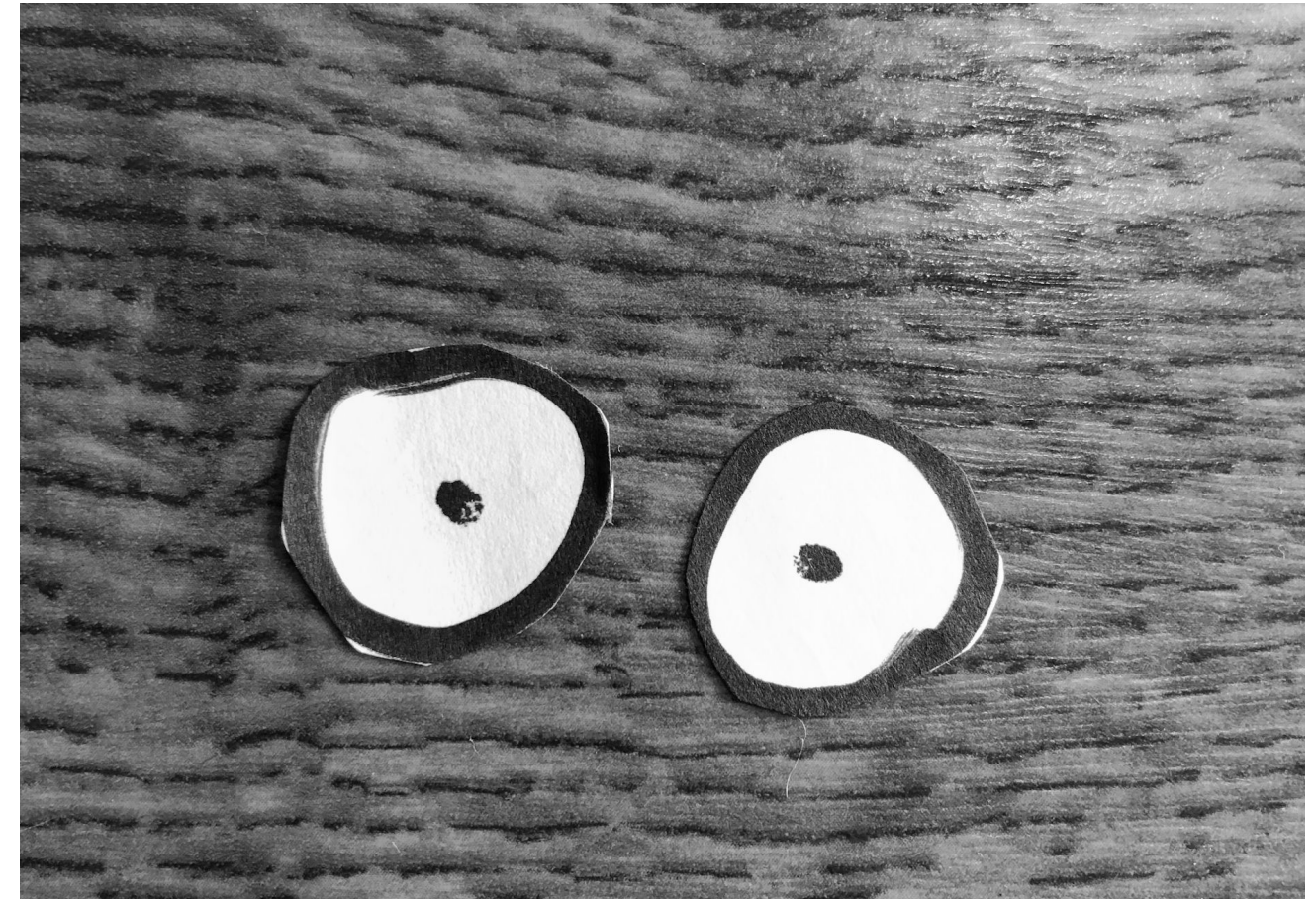
1. Draw two eyes on your paper with a pen





## Step 3

1. Cut out the eyes with your scissors, with the help of an adult



## Step 4

1. Use sellotape to stick the eyes on the sock





## Step 5

1. Put your hand in the sock to make him talk!



# Step 6

1. Try using different socks, and different decorations
