First, find the things you will need




1. Choose a sock and lay it flat






Draw two eyes on your paper

1. Cut out the eyes with your scissors, with the help of an adult





 Use sellotape to stick the eyes on the sock





1. Put your hand in the sock to make him talk!





1. Try using different socks, and different
