The present continuous with -ER and -IR verbs



Use the **present continuous** for an ongoing action that is happening *right now*.

Use the correct person of the present tense of **estar** and a present participle.

To make the present participle:

-ar verbs remove '-ar' and add '-ando'.

Ejemplos:

estoy grabando = lam recording

estás hablando = You are speaking

está escapando = S/he, it is escaping

-er and -ir verbs remove '-er/-ir' and add '-iendo'.

Ejemplos:

estoy conduciendo = lam driving

estás traduciendo = You are translating

está discutiendo = S/he, it is arguing



Querer + infinitive vs estar + present participle



You know that <u>modal verbs</u> such as *deber*, *poder* and *querer* can be followed by an **infinitive**.

Estar is not a modal verb. It can be followed by the present participle but

not the infinitive.

decidir is the infinitive.

Compare:

Queremos decidir. = We want to decide.

Note: the present participle means *-ing*, the infinitive means *(to) do*.

Estamos decidiendo. = We are deciding.

decidiendo is the present participle.



Summary

- To say what you are doing right now in Spanish, use the present continuous.
- 2. Use the present of <u>estar</u> and a <u>present participle</u>.
- 3. To make the present participle for -er/-ir verbs, remove -er/-ir and add -iendo .
- 4. 'We are writing a film' = Estamos escribiendo una película.
- 5. But 'we want to direct a film' = Queremos dirigir una película.
