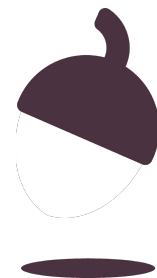

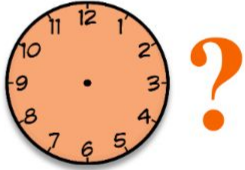

Forming en + the present participle



1. Take the nous form of the verb in the present tense.
2. Remove the nous and the '-ons' ending
3. Add 'en' before the verb, and 'ant' after

Whilst/on/by playing	Nous jouons	jou	en jouant
Whilst/on/by choosing	Nous choisissons	choisiss	en choisissant
Whilst/on/by eating	Nous mangeons	mange	en mangeant



Reviewing a restaurant



1. When forming the present participle, you need to take the ... form of the verb from the present tense.	nous
2. Then you remove the ... from the end	ons
3. Then you add ... to the start and ... to the end	en, ant
4. En payant has three possible meanings =	Whilst/on/by paying
5. 'L'accueil était chaleureux' =	The welcome was warm
