## Teacher notes- Shopping in the supermarket

Learning Intention- To match shopping items to the correct aisle depending on category. To identify the correct coins for the price of the item.

1. Discuss what you need to have before going shopping.
2. Read and write/find the symbol of the item on the shopping list. You could collect the items on the list and play the game as you follow the lesson.
3. Choose which aisle you would find the item. Discuss the type of food found on the isles and why it is categorised.
4. Use real coins or those on the screens to count the correct amount depending on the price.
5. Repeat for each item. You could extend learning at each step.

Resources- coins and box/bag and real shopping items if wanted.

## Lesson Activity Stages

## 1. Read the shopping list

2. Find the correct aisle
3. What coins do I need?
4. My shopping basket

## What do we need?

Discuss what you need before going shopping.
Can you find these items?
If you have a real bag or box you could collect the shopping
items and put them in the bag or box as you follow the lesson.

Ask - "Which aisle do we find tomatoes in? Are they in the dairy aisle or fruit and veg aisle?"
Model pointing to the correct answer if your learner needs support. If you are using real tomatoes, encourage your learner to put them into their bag.

Ask - "Which aisle do we find bread in? Is it in the bakery aisle or soft drinks aisle?" Model pointing to the correct answer if your learner needs support. If you are using real bread, encourage your learner to put it into their bag.

Look at the cost of the item. Can you make $£ 1.20$ with the coins you have or with the coins on the slide? Are there more ways of making $£ 1.20$ ? You could hold up the correct real coin(s) and ask your learner to match it to the coin(s) on the slides.

## Make it easier

-Practise packing a bag.

- Follow the lesson without counting coins.

Make it harder
-Introduce other aisles in a supermarket.

- Discuss reason for fridge aisles.
-Copy the game; exchanging correct money for items.


## More ideas

-Make a real shopping list for the supermarket.
-Explore online supermarkets with parent/carer.

- Locate barcodes on items in preparation for using a self service checkout.
