2. Explain two different religious beliefs about polygamy.




Match the terms and definitions

Fornication	A married person having sex with someone other than their spouse.
Adultery	Sex before marriage or between two single unmarried people.
Sexual Immorality	The state of abstaining from marriage and sexual relations.
Celibacy	The state or practice of refraining from sexual intercourse before or outside of marriage
Chastity	The state of living together and having a sexual relationship without being married.
Cohabitation	The legally or formally recognized union of two people as partners in a personal relationship (historically and in some jurisdictions, specifically a union between a man and a woman).
Marriage	Forbidden or proscribed by Islamic law
Haram	Sex outside marriage (i.e. fornication or adultery).
