

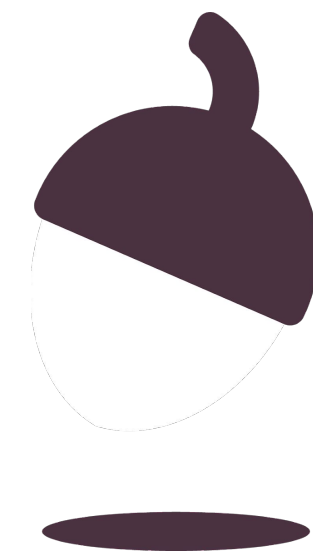

Using a range of tenses

Perfect:

Ich **habe** Schokolade **gegessen**.

Don't forget you need a form of **haben/sein** and a **past participle** at the end of the sentence. Remember regular past participles add a 'ge' and end in 't' and irregular often end in 'en'

Present:

Ich feiere **e** gern Karneval.

Look at the pronoun to identify the verb endings: **-e, -st, -t, -en, -t, -en.**

Future:

Ich w**erde** Zeit mit Familie **verbringen**.

Don't forget you need the present tense of '**werden**' and an **infinitive** at the end of the sentence:
ich werde
er/sie wird
wir werden



How do you
make a question
in these tenses?

- if there is no question word simply switch the **pronoun** and the **verb** around
- if there is a question word again simply switch the **pronoun** and the **verb** around

When did you buy the present?

Wann **hast du** das Geschenk gekauft?

What present will you buy?

Was für ein Geschenke **wirst du**
kaufen?

Did you buy a present?

Hast du ein Geschenk gekauft?

Do you have a present?

Hast du ein Geschenk?
