1. Annabel is x years old.

Her friend Rosie is 2 years older than Annabel.

I find the product of their ages.

Which expressions match this situation?

2. A rectangular garden is 2m shorter than it is wide.

I find the area of the field.

Which expressions match this situation?

$x^2 + 2$	$3(2+x)$
$x^2 + 2x$	$x(x+2)$
$x^2 - 2$	$x^2 - 2x$
$x(x-2)$	$= 2x^2$



Explore

A square is cut out of a 9 cm x 4 cm rectangle.

- Form an expression to describe the area of the resulting shape.
- Are there different ways to find this expression?
- Graph it
- What is the maximum and minimum area?
