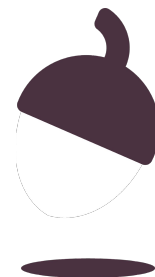

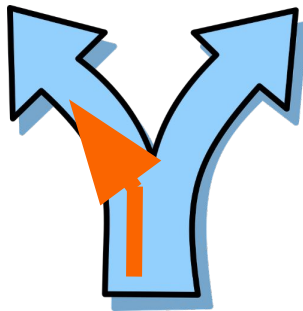

Using possessive adjectives



Possessive adjectives are used to indicate possession or ownership of a noun (a person/place or thing).

Ton / ta / tes Your (informal)	Votre / vos Your (formal)
Mon / ma / mes My	Notre / nos Our (singular)
