Remember to:

- Find the <u>unison</u> notes from your own interlocking melodies
- Add a Gong (G) and Kempul (K) part to your piece at the unison points
- Add a gong (G) note to the end of the <u>ostinato</u> (repeating pattern of sounds)
- Leave rests the gongs play very rarely to emphasise parts of the pattern of notes.
