

Independent practice Answers

- 1. Suggest why, if large numbers of arctic cod were removed by humans:
- a) the ringed seal population may decrease

 Because the ringed seals feed on the arctic cod and if
 there were fewer arctic cod the ringed seals may not
 have enough food to survive
- b) the zooplankton population may increase

 Because there would be fewer arctic cod to eat the
 zooplankton so more would survive
