


Describing activities different people do [1/2]

- Using subject pronouns: yo ('I') & tú ('you') & hacer



Using subject pronouns: yo ('I') & tú ('you') & hacer

In Spanish, remember the verb (or its ending) tells us **who** it refers to.

Here is an example with the verb *hacer* (to do/make):

Hago = I do / make.

Haces = you do / make.

When comparing different people, Spanish uses a subject pronoun (e.g. I, you, he) before the verb. This makes it clear who the verb refers to.

Yo hago la cama, mientras que **tú** no haces tareas.

I make the bed, whereas **you** don't do tasks.

So, '**yo**' means '**I**' and '**tú**' means '**you**'.

In English, we always use the subject pronoun here too!





Using subject pronouns: él ('he') & ella ('she') & hacer

To say '**s/he does**' or '**s/he makes**' you say: **hace**.

Sometimes it is unclear from the verb alone whether it refers to 'he' or 'she'.

So, we can use the subject pronouns: **él** (he) and **ella** (she)

Él hace la comida mientras **ella** hace deporte.

He makes the food while **she** does sport.



Using ‘hacer’ in 1st and 3rd person plural

To talk about **what we do** or **someone does** we use ‘**hacer**’

Hacemos una llamada por Skype.

We do a Skype call.

Hacen una presentación.

They do a presentation.
