# Present continuous tense

We use the present continuous tense to describe an action you are doing at the moment. It is formed of two parts:



# Present continuous -ar verbs

Descansar = to relax

*Compare:*

Estoy descansando

I am relaxing

Estás descansando

You are relaxing

Which part changes and which part stays the same?

descans- → descans**ando**      relaxing



# Present continuous -er/-ir verbs

Salir = to go out

*Compare:*

Estoy saliendo

I am going out

Estás saliendo

You are going out

Which part changes and which part stays the same?

sal- → **saliendo**    going out

viv- → **viviendo**    living

[want | I want]

# quieres

[want | you want]



# quieres

[you want]

Quieres un móvil.

[**You want** a mobile phone.]



# quiero

[want | I want]

Quiero un móvil

[I want a mobile phone.]



## Summary - Las respuestas

1. We use the present continuous to describe an action taking place now
2. We need the verb estar + present participle
3. “*Estoy descansando*” means “I am relaxing”
4. “*Quiero*” means “I want”
5. “*¿Quieres salir?*” means  
“Do you want to go out?”
