Me and My Friends 1 Music Activity

See Saw - High and Low

Did you have fun playing the see saw with a member of your family or your teddy?

This activity will help you explore high and low sounds.





You will need.....

- Two things from your home that you can tap.
 - They should make 2 different sounds.
 - They could be made of different materials or be different sizes.



Explore!

Listen to all the different sounds that objects make as you tap them. Be careful not to break anything - be gentle!

Does the length of the object change the sound when you tap it? Can you make a sound in another way apart from tapping - like shaking? Or scraping?

Does the type of beater you use change the sound?

Does the material make a difference to the sound?

Does the size of the object change the sound when you tap it?



Find!

Now find your favourite two objects. Make sure they **sound different** from each other. Here are some ideas:

Hollow objects:

- Biscuit tin
- Lunchbox
- Kitchen pan turned upside down

Long and Short objects:

Toilet roll - Kitchen towel roll



Play

- 1. Try tapping both your objects one after the other to explore the high and low sounds. Decide which one will be your high sound and which one will be your low sound.
- 2. Then see if you can play your homemade percussion set to match the see-saw pattern.


