## Find volumes of similar shapes given corresponding lengths

3. Here are two similar vases.


Alisha says that it will take double the amount of water to fill the larger vase because it is double the height.
Show that Alisha is wrong.
Linear scale factor $=2$
Volume of larger vase $=360 \times 2^{3}=2880 \mathrm{~cm}^{3}$
4. Pentagonal prisms $A$ and $B$ are similar.


Work out the side length marked x .
Volume scale factor $=27$
Linear scale factor $=\sqrt[3]{27}=3$
Side $x=6 \times 3=18 \mathrm{~cm}$
