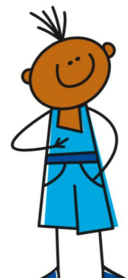
Regular -er verbs

To form the present tense with a regular ER verb.

1. Remove the ER from the infinitive
2. Add the correct ending.



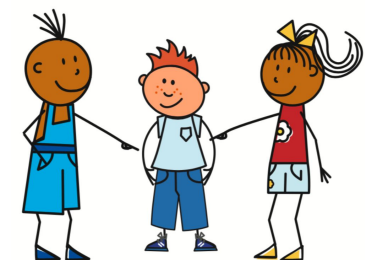
Ferm**er** - To close



Je ferm**e** - I close



Tu ferm**es** - You close



Il ferm**e** - He closes



Nous ferm**ons** - We close



Vous ferm**ez** - You close



Ils ferm**ent** - They close
