


- Templates of a rectangle, circle and triangle - ask an adult to draw these for you or use the templates at the end of this resource.


## Matching shapes

**Ask a parent or carer to help you make shape templates and gather objects from around the house.**


**Place your shape templates and objects in front of you.**

# Numeracy: Shape and Sorting - Building Understanding

## Lesson 1: Recognising and matching 2D shapes to a template

### Make it easier

Make all your shapes the same size to make them easier to recognise.

Make all similar shapes the same colour as your template to help you to recognise them.

### Make it harder

Try turning your shapes around into a different orientation.

Can you still match them?

Put different shapes together to make pictures.

### More ideas

If you have used salt dough, you could ask your parent or carer to bake your shapes to make decorations for your house.

Ask your parent or carer to help you cut shapes of different sizes into potatoes and make prints using paint
