



# Irregular verbs

## Faire - to do / to make

Je **fais** = I **do / make**



To refer to yourself



Je **fais** le lit = I **make** the bed



Je **fais** la cuisine = I **do** the cooking






# Irregular verbs

## Faire - to do / to make


Use **faire** to describe what you are doing or making.

Il **fait** = He **does / makes**



To refer to a singular male

Elle **fait** = She **does / makes**



To refer to a singular female





# Irregular verbs

## Faire - to do / to make

Use **faire** to describe what you are doing or making.

Il **fait** le lit



He **makes** the bed

Elle **fait** la cuisine



She **does** the cooking
