



Je fais = | do / make



To refer to yourself







Je fais la cuisine = I do the cooking

Faire - to do / to make


Use faire to describe what you are doing or making.

|| fait = He does / makes



To refer to a singular male

Elle fait = She does / makes



To refer to a singular female




Irregular verbs



Faire - to do / to make

Use **faire** to describe what you are doing or making.

Il **fait** le lit



He makes the bed

Elle fait la cuisine



She does the cooking
