What might someone say?

Ways someone might use sexual coercion	What they might say
Wearing you down by asking for sex again and again or making you feel bad, guilty, or obligated	
Making you feel like it's too late to say no	
Telling you that <i>not</i> having sex will hurt your relationship	
Lying or threatening to spread rumors about you	
Making promises to reward you for sex	
Threatening your children or other family members	
Threatening your job, home, or school career	
Threatening to reveal your sexual orientation publicly or to family or friends
