<b>I</b>	-o	-i	-bam
<b>You (s)</b>	-s	-isti	-bas
<b>He, she, it</b>	-t	-it	-bat
<b>We</b>	-mus	-imus	-bamus
<b>You (pl)</b>	-tis	-istis	-batis
<b>They</b>	-nt	-erunt	-bant
