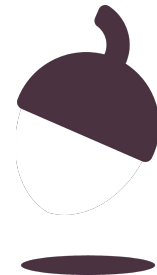

Indirect object pronouns

We use **indirect object pronouns** with **verbs** which are **followed by** the preposition **à**

Indirect object pronouns replace the **preposition** and the **noun** in a sentence.

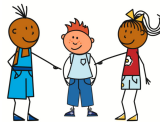
Je **lui** écris = I write to him / her



me or m' = (to) me



te or t' = (to) you



lui = (to) him or her



nous = (to) us



vous = (to) you (plural)



leur = (to) them
