When talking about jobs people do in French, you do not use the indefinite article ('un'/'une') before the job title.

1. The articles ‘un’ and ‘une’ mean ‘a’ or ‘one’
2. I am a teacher = *Je suis professeur*
3. He is a hairdresser = *Il est coiffeur*
4. She is a computer scientist = *Elle est informaticienne*
5. He works in a shop = *Il travaille dans un magasin*
6. She works outdoors = *Elle travaille en plein air*
