The Irregular Verbs *volo* and *nolo*

<i>volo</i> (I want)		<i>nolo</i> (I do not want)	
<i>volo</i>	I want	<i>nolo</i>	I do not want
<i>vis</i>	You (s) want	<i>non vis</i>	You (s) do not want
<i>vult</i>	She wants	<i>non vult</i>	She does not want
<i>volumus</i>	We want	<i>nolumus</i>	We do not want
<i>vultis</i>	You (pl) want	<i>non vultis</i>	You (pl) do not want
<i>volunt</i>	They want	<i>nolunt</i>	They do not want
