passionnant (exciting)	passionnants	passionnant ^{es}
amusant (amusing)	amusants	amusant ^{es}
divertissant (entertaining)	divertissants	divertissant ^{es}
intéressant (interesting)	intéressants	intéressant ^{es}
marrant (funny)	marrants	intéressant ^{es}
barbant (boring)	barbants	barbant ^{es}



Adjectives- masculine plural and feminine plural.



Adjective	masculine plural	feminine plural
éducatif (educational)	éducatifs	éducatives
sérieux (serious)	sérieux	sérieuses
ennuyeux (boring)	ennuyeux	ennuyeuses
original (original)	originaux	originales



Talking about TV programmes (1/3)

1. Most adjectives in French come the noun they describe.	after
2. The spelling of the adjective changes according to the gender of the noun and also whether it is	singular or plural
3. The plural endings for adjectives that end in -t are:	s (masculine) es (feminine)
4. Je préfère means	I prefer
5. Préféré(e)(s) is an and means	adjective / favourite
