The Irregular Verb 'to be'

Present Tense	
<i>sum</i>	I am
<i>es</i>	You (s) are
<i>est</i>	She is
<i>sumus</i>	We are
<i>estis</i>	You (pl) are
<i>sunt</i>	They are
