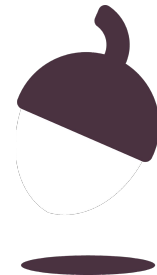

The infinitive can also be translated by the gerund.

attirer = **to** attract AND attract**ing**

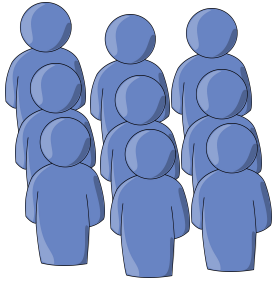


Pouvoir - to be able to (irregular verb)



People can =

Les gens peuvent



To refer to people in general
3rd person plural

Big events can =

Les grands événements peuvent



3rd person plural

Use **pouvoir** with an infinitive to say what someone or something **can** do



The advantages of big events

1. Translate: Big events	Les grands événements
2. Translate: On peut	You (general) can
3. Translate: People can	Les gens peuvent
4. Translate: Big events can	Les grands événements peuvent
5. The verb pouvoir is followed by the which ends in	Infinitive ER / IR / RE
