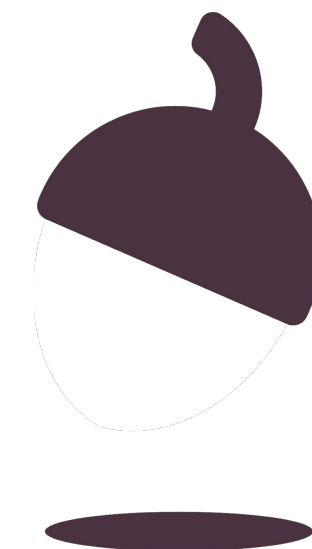

Tu = You	as	emprunt ER - emprunt É
Il / Elle = He / She	a	pratiqu ER - pratiqu É

Ils / Elles	ont

Sometimes the past participle is **irregular!**

boire - **bu**

avoir - **eu**

apprendre - **appris**

comprendre - **compris**

prendre - **pris**



Noticing similar patterns

J'ai **bu**

boire

I drank

J'ai **eu**

avoir

I had



Noticing similar patterns

J'ai **pris**

prendre

I took

J'ai **appris**

apprendre

I learnt

J'ai **compris**

comprendre

I understood
