Devoir - to have to/must





Je doi**s**- I must/have to



"Il doi**t** - He must / has to



Elle doi**t** - She must / has to



Tu doi**s** - You (specific) must / have to



On doi**t** - You (general) must/have to



Devoir - to have to / must

Use **devoir** with an infinitive to say what you must do:

Je dois rester chez moi.



I must stay at home.

Je dois faire les magasins.



I must go shopping.



Savoir - to know (how to)





Je sai**s**- I know



Il sai**t** - He knows



Elle sai**t** - She knows



Tu sai**s** - You (specific)



On sai**t** - You (general) know



Savoir - to know how to do something

Use **savoir** with an infinitive to say what you **know how to do**:

Je sais jouer au tennis



I know **how** to play tennis

Je sais parler l'anglais



I know **how** to speak English

- 1. The verb devoir means to have to / must
- 2. I must = je dois
- 3. The verb savoir means = to be know (how to)
- 4. I know = je sais
- 5. He must = il doit
- 6. You (specific) know = tu sais
