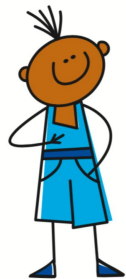

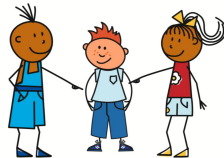
Devoir - to have to/must



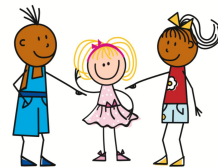
Je dois - I must/have to



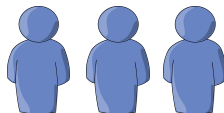
Tu dois - You (specific) must / have to



Il doit - He must / has to



Elle doit - She must / has to



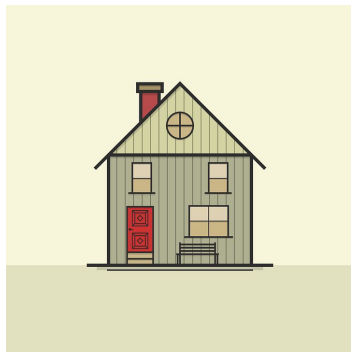
On doit - You (general) must/have to



Devoir - to have to / must

Use **devoir** with an infinitive to say what you must do:

Je dois rester chez moi.



I must stay at home.

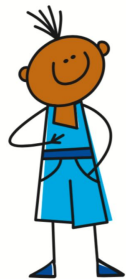
Je dois faire les magasins.



I must go shopping.



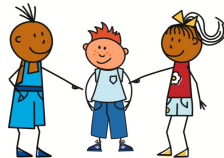
Savoir - to know (how to)



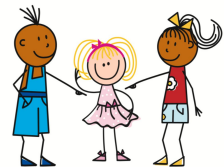
Je sais**s** - I know



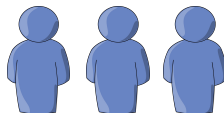
Tu sais**s** - You (specific)
know



Il sait**t** - He knows



Elle sait**t** - She knows



On sait**t** - You (general)
know



Savoir - to know how to do something

Use **savoir** with an infinitive to say what you **know how to do** :

Je sais jouer au tennis



I know **how** to play tennis

Je sais parler l'anglais



I know **how** to speak English



Say what you want to do and must do [1/2]



1. The verb **devoir** means **to have to / must**
2. I must = **je dois**
3. The verb **savoir** means = **to be know (how to)**
4. I know = **je sais**
5. He must = **il doit**
6. You (specific) know = **tu sais**
