# Grammatik

Using "es gäbe" + accusative

"es hätte"    "es wäre"



**es gäbe** = *there would be*. Just like **es gibt**, **es gab** and **es wird geben** this phrase is used with nouns in the accusative. The noun follows **es gäbe**.

	<b>Masculine</b>	<b>Feminine</b>	<b>Neuter</b>	<b>Plural</b>
<b>Nominative</b>	ein Freizeitpark	eine Eisbahn	ein Sportzentrum	(viele) Klubs
<b>Es gäbe + accusative</b>	einen Freizeitpark	eine Eisbahn	ein Sportzentrum	(viele) Klubs
<b>Translation</b>	<i>there would be a theme park.</i>	<i>there would be be an ice rink.</i>	<i>there would be a sports centre.</i>	<i>there would be (many) clubs.</i>



**es gäbe** = *there would be*. Just like **es gibt**, **es gab** and **es wird geben** this phrase could be followed by the negative article to say that there wouldn't be something.

	<b>Masculine</b>	<b>Feminine</b>	<b>Neuter</b>	<b>Plural</b>
<b>Nominative</b>	ein Freizeitpark	eine Eisbahn	ein Sportzentrum	(viele) Klubs
<b>Es gäbe + accusative</b>	keinen Freizeitpark	keine Eisbahn	kein Sportzentrum	(keine) Klubs
<b>Translation</b>	<i>there would not be a theme park.</i>	<i>there would not be be an ice rink.</i>	<i>there would not be a sports centre.</i>	<i>there would not be (any) clubs.</i>

<b>die Hallenbäder</b>	<b>viele Hallenbäder</b>

Noun	Noun with es gäbe
<b>der Flughafen</b>	<b>keinen Flughafen</b>
<b>die Stadthalle</b>	<b>keine Stadthalle</b>
<b>das Fitnesszentrum</b>	<b>kein Fitnesszentrum</b>
<b>die Hallenbäder</b>	<b>keine Hallenbäder</b>



***There are also two more useful phrases when talking about an ideal town***

<b>Die Stadt hätte.....</b>	<b><i>The town would have.....</i></b>
<b>Die Stadt hätte einen See.</b>	<b><i>The town would have a lake.</i></b>

<b>Die Stadt wäre...</b>	<b><i>The town would be.....</i></b>
<b>Die Stadt wäre schön.</b>	<b><i>The town would be beautiful.</i></b>



# Compare and contrast!

<b>Die Stadt <b>hatte</b> einen Bahnhof.</b>	<b><i>The town <b>had</b> a station.</i></b>	<b>PAST</b>
<b>Die Stadt <b>hätte</b> einen Bahnhof.</b>	<b><i>The town <b>would have</b> a station.</i></b>	<b>CONDITIONAL</b>


<b>Die Stadt <b>war</b> schön.</b>	<b><i>The town <b>was</b> beautiful.</i></b>	<b>PAST</b>
<b>Die Stadt <b>wäre</b> schön.</b>	<b><i>The town <b>would be</b> beautiful.</i></b>	<b>CONDITIONAL</b>



# Compare and contrast!

<b>Es gab einen Bahnhof.</b>	<b>There was a station.</b>	PAST
<b>Es <u>gäbe</u> einen Bahnhof.</b>	<b>There <u>would be</u> a station.</b>	CONDITIONAL
<b>Es gab viele Kneipen.</b>	<b>There were many bars.</b>	PAST
<b>Es <u>gäbe</u> viele Kneipen.</b>	<b>There <u>would be</u> many bars.</b>	CONDITIONAL





# Summary of learning

**In German, es gäbe (there would be) is used with the accusative as follows:**

	<b>Masculine</b>	<b>Feminine</b>	<b>Neuter</b>	<b>Plural</b>
<b>es gäbe</b>	ein <b>en</b> Strand	eine <b>ne</b> Eisbahn	ein <b>ne</b> Stadion	viele <b>ne</b> Klubs

**If you want to say there won't be something, the pattern is as follows:**

<b>es gäbe</b>	<b>keinen</b> Strand	<b>keine</b> Eisbahn	<b>kein</b> Stadion	<b>keine</b> Klubs
----------------	----------------------	----------------------	---------------------	--------------------
